Chairman Josh Feucht convened the adjourned session with Altena, Birkey, and Herman present. Motion carried assumes unanimous vote unless otherwise stated. Supervisor Vanden Bosch was absent.

The Board started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from the July 13, 2021 meeting were reviewed. Motion by Altena, second by Herman to approve and Chairman sign minutes with correction to ambulance call time moving from \$4.50/hr to \$5.50/hr. and \$11.50/hr. to \$10.50/hr for FY2022. Motion carried.

Resolution 2021-18 was introduced for budget amendment #1 approved on July 13, 2021. The Resolution was forgotten on 7-13-2021. The public hearing was held on 7-13-2021 and the Board had moved to approve the amendment. The amendment was for increased expenditures of a gravel pit purchase, FY2021 flyover cost, and additional costs associated with Document Locator program. The total increase was \$1,211,566. Motion by Altena, second by Birkey to approve and sign Resolution 2021-18. Motion carried. This is a summary of Resolution 2021-18. The full text can be obtained at the Auditor's Office or online at www.lyoncountyiowa.com under Supervisors then Resolutions.

Sheriff quarterly report was reviewed. Motion by Herman, second by Birkey to approve report. Motion carried.

The Board has received a road closure request from Jen Elyea to close Clinton Street to Thomas Street from 7:30 pm to 2:30 am for a street dance in Lester. Motion by Birkey, second by Altena to approve closure request. Motion carried.

With Amie Griesse being appointed to County Recorder, benefits earned must be paid out. Earned benefits of \$7,086.38 are owed to Griesse. Motion by Altena, second by Birkey to approve payout to Griesse. Motion carried.

Conservation Director Craig Van Otterloo met with the Board to discuss a budget amendment for \$110,000 from fund 71000 for costs associated with the new nature center. 5% retainage costs (\$79,733) are still owed to Peska. There will be a meeting this afternoon to determine what the costs for doors that were changed out instead of using the security ones requested. Van Otterloo also states that the indoor fence/gates will be \$13,200, and this fall Van Otterloo wants to finish up the trail from the back of the new education center to the current trail in concrete (about 400 feet) at an estimated \$12,500 for concrete and there will be a water scape bid coming yet. Van Otterloo also talked about how he has met the \$300,000 revenue goal that he set when he became director. Van Otterloo talked about his retirement at the end of December. The plans are to have applications for the director position received by August 20th, interviews held in September, and someone hired by first part of October. The Board thanked Van Otterloo for all the work he has done over the years building up Lake Pahoja and conservation programs in the County and wished him well in future endeavors.

The Board needs to set a public hearing date for budget amendment #2 which will be for costs for the new nature center. Motion by Birkey, second by Herman to set a public hearing date of August 10 at 8:45 am for budget amendment #2. Motion carried.

Gerald Zwart with Globe Life Family Heritage Insurance was present to talk to the Board regarding supplemental insurance. Zwart explained that the Family Heritage has been around for 30+ years and is now under Globe Life umbrella. The voluntary insurance plans are a return of premium plan. At age 65 your premiums minus any payments made on your behalf are returned to you. Zwart states that the premiums are not dependent on the number of employees that participate. Zwart would like to have the opportunity to offer to the plan to the employees. The Board would like to have this offered to the employees for open enrollment for 2022.

Sam Chase, County Representative for ICAP insurance, joined the meeting to present the FY2022 insurance renewal. Due to the Derecho that occurred in Iowa last year, ICAP is not giving any member credits for FY2022. The FY2022 premium for ICAP will be \$206,431 and work comp premium will be \$84,068, for a total premium of \$290,499. FY21 total premium was \$249,781. Motion by Birkey, second by Altena to approve and sign the renewal. Motion carried.

Economic Development Director Steve Simons gave an update on upcoming meetings, the Iowa Gallivant story, and more information on the Trail Run of Blood Run.

Chairman Feucht presented the ISAC HIPAA Agreement that will give the County two HIPAA trainings a year for \$1,950.00. The trainings include a HIPAA 101 webinar and a one day in-person training for up to 5 people. Motion by Herman, second by Altena to approve and sign the agreement. Motion carried.

Dave Jackson, Road Superintendent and Randy Hage, Engineer Tech were present from the Engineer's office. There were questions regarding the liquidated damages in connection with the Lester paving project. Hage stated there were 28.5 days at \$1,000/day and that amount was held from the contract payment. Hage states there was a meeting held with the contractor where those days were agreed upon. Hage referenced the agreement which was signed by the City and County that states the City of Lester would receive zero dollars of any liquidated damages assessed. The City of Lester is asking for a portion of the liquidated damages. The Board decided that as Supervisor Vanden Bosch was absent they would table the decision until their next meeting on 8-10-2021.

Motion by Herman, second by Birkey to approve and sign claims. Motion carried.
