LYON COUNTY AUDITORS OFFICE May 23, 2023

Chairman Jerry Birkey convened the adjourned session with Vanden Bosch, Scholten, Altena, and Herman present. Motion carried assumes unanimous vote unless otherwise stated.

The Board started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Kayla Meyer with Cherokee Public Health joined the Board meeting to discuss the Child Health and Oral Health program. Meyer stated the Cherokee Public Health has taken over this program as MidSioux did apply to continue. Meyer is requesting \$10,000 from 10 counties to help lift the program for this first year. Meyer feels next fiscal year's request if needed would be very minimal as she hopes once staff (7 total) is onboarded and trained the billing income will support the program. Motion by Vanden Bosch to give \$5,000 to the program after July 1, second by Herman. Motion carried. The Board will determine which fund to take the money from after the start of the new fiscal year.

Chairman Birkey opened the public hearing at 8:53 a.m. to take comment on the proposed development agreement with Diversified Technologies, Inc. Present were: Steve Simons, Economic Development Director, Elijah Helton, NWIA Review. As no comments or questions were presented, public hearing closed at 8:55 a.m.

Resolution 2023-22 was introduced approving the development agreement with DTI, Inc. and authorizing annual appropriation tax increment payments and pledging certain tax increment revenue to the payment of the agreement. The development agreement gives back up to a maximum of \$800,000 in tax increment dollars. Motion by Herman, second by Altena to approve and sign Resolution 2023-22. Motion carried. Rollcall vote: District 1 Vanden Bosch Support, District 2 Scholten Support, District 3 Altena Support, District 4 Birkey Support, District 5 Herman Support. Motion carried. The Board reviewed the HIPAA Agreement with ISAC for another year. Motion by Altena, second by Scholten to approve and sign agreement. Motion carried.

Emergency Action item requested to be added is a street closure for June  $9^{th}$  for the Inwood Tractor Pull. It is requested to close W. Jefferson Street on June  $9^{th}$  for the event. Motion by Vanden Bosch, second by Scholten. Motion carried.

County Engineer Daryl Albertson joined the meeting. Motion by Altena, second by Herman to approve and sign amended IaDoT budget #1 for Fy2023. Motion carried. Motion by Altena, second by Herman to approve and sign amended IaDoT budget #2 for FY2023. Motion carried.

Resolution 2023-24 approves the resurfacing/cold in place project on A18 to be awarded to Duininck, Inc for \$2,494,687.23 as low bidder. Motion by Vanden Bosch, second by Scholten to approve Resolution 2023-24. Motion carried. This is a summary of the resolution. Motion by Altena, seconded by Vanden Bosch to approve and sign Resolution 2023-23 Approval of FY2023 Budget Amendment #4. This amendment includes the \$175,000 from secondary roads for a down payment on real estate, and \$6,002 covering credits to be paid out in a TIF district and the transfer of the funds from Fund 01010 to Fund 01000 due to an error at the end of FY22. There was discussion on how to find an engineer/architect to get the process started. Smit will ask other auditors in the district for recommendations. Vanden Bosch MidSioux; Scholten - Board of Health; Altena NW IA Landfill, last NW IA Workforce Development meeting as commission is dissolving, IT Director conversation as chosen candidate declined the offer. County could continue to do a hybrid position with Premier and work towards a fulltime position in the upcoming future. The Board decided to have Supervisor Altena have conversations with Premier to determine what the cost would be to look at a narrowed contract for services.

Employment changes: Sheriff Deputy Mitchel Van Beek will be moved to 77% (74,741) of the Sheriff salary as of 5-1-2023.
