LYON COUNTY AUDITORS OFFICE November 26, 2024

Chairman Jerry Birkey convened the adjourned session with Vanden Bosch, Scholten, Altena, and Herman present. Motion carried assumes unanimous vote unless otherwise stated.

The Board started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from the November 13, 2024 meeting and work session and the November 19, 2024 special meeting were reviewed. Motion by Altena, second by Vanden Bosch to approve and Chairman sign minutes. Motion carried.

Auditor Amy Sprock presented the Post Election Audit Report to the Board of Supervisors.

Chairman Birkey opened the public hearing at 8:45 a.m. to take public comment on the proposal to incur noncurrent debt in relation to the Lyon County Economic Development Urban Renewal projects. Present were: Isaac Yeager from New Century Press, Daryl Albertson the Lyon County Engineer, and Jen Smit the Lyon County Economic Development Director. There were no comments or questions. Chairman Birkey closed the hearing at 8:46 a.m.

Resolution 2024-35 approving an internal loan to fund urban renewal project costs was introduced. The amount will be \$470,000 to fund secondary roads projects. Motion by Herman, second by Altena to approve and sign resolution. Motion carried. This is a summary of the resolution. Chairman Birkey opened the public hearing at 8:50 a.m. to take comment on the plan amendment for the Lyon County Economic Development Urban Renewal Area. Present were: Isaac Yeager from New Century Press, Daryl Albertson the Lyon County Engineer, and Jen Smit the Lyon County Economic Development Director. Since there were no comments or questions, the hearing was closed at 8:51 a.m. Resolution 2024-36 was introduced to approve the urban renewal plan amendment. The amendment would include graveling of secondary roads in various districts with an amount of \$470,000 being reimbursed by TIF. Motion by Herman, second by Altena to approve and sign resolution. The Board reviewed the 12-1-2024 county TIF debt certifications for FY25/26. Casino TIF \$470,000 for gravel resurfacing, box culverts, and bridge project, DTI TIF \$800,000 certified for 150,000 sq ft building, and DuraLift TIF no new debt certified.

Motion by Herman, second by Altena to approve DTI TIF certification. Motion carried.

Motion by Altena, second by Vanden Bosch to approve DuraLift TIF certification. Motion carried.

Motion by Vanden Bosch, second by Scholten to approve Casino TIF certification. Motion carried.

Chairman Birkey presented the Police contract with Alvord. Motion by Herman, second by Altena. Motion carried

Family Crisis Center was present to give an overview of what they provide to Lyon County residents. They gave their annual report as well as requesting \$12,000 for FY2026. The Board thanked him for coming and stated they will discuss contribution during budgeting.

Jen Smit gave an update on the Big Challenge competition from 11-21-2024. A local business CA Performance Horses and Marketing was the winner. They are a Marketing company and also breed horses. Smit stated that last year's winner also came from Lyon County.

Smit stated she is currently working on business retention surveys throughout cities in Lyon County. Smit gave an update on multiple projects that cities are working on in their communities.

CAPS program is currently focusing on social media for this next semester.

Smit presented multiple options for a location for her office. Motion by Altena, second by Vanden Bosch to move forward with the location at Frontier Bank. Birkey and Herman opposed. Motion carried.

Motion by Altena, second by Scholten, to appoint Bruce Fick to the Zoning Board. Motion carried.

Motion by Herman, second by Altena, to pay DGS/DAS, Inc rent from July, August, September, October, and November for the south side of the Dollar General building. Motion carried. The Board will continue to pay until all departments are moved out of the building.

Auditor Sprock gathered information for the Board to possibly use a company to handle the bids and leasing of county land. The Board would like keep the process the same as previous years.

Lyon County Engineer Daryl Albertson was present to give an update on current projects and answer any questions. The Board thanked him for coming.

Motion by Scholten, second by Vanden Bosch to approve claims. Motion carried.
