A RESOLUTION OF LYON COUNTY ADOPTING THE LYON COUNTY ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN.

WHEREAS Lyon County recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Lyon County; and

WHEREAS Lyon County has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as Lyon County Iowa All Hazards Mitigation Plan in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS Lyon County identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Lyon County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the Lyon County Board of Supervisors demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the All Hazards Mitigation Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Lyon County Iowa Board of Supervisore, THAT:

Section 1. In accordance with Iowa Law, the Lyon County Board of Supervisors adopts the Lyon County All Hazards Mitigation Plan. While content related to Lyon County may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require Lyon County to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
