RESOLUTION APPROVING WITHDRAWAL FROM AMENDMENT PROCESS REGARDING PHARMACY BENEFIT MANAGERS IN OPIOID LITIGATION

WHEREAS, Lyon County has participated as a plaintiff with other governmental entities in a series of class action lawsuits against opioid manufacturers and other parties alleged to be responsible for the opioid epidemic in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Lyon County has the opportunity to pursue claims against Pharmacy Benefit Managers alleged to be responsible for the dispensary of opioid medications; and

WHEREAS, pursuit of these claims would be initiated by amendment of petitions previously filed against other defendants in the opioid litigation; and

WHEREAS, Lyon County has been advised by its class-action counsel that it would be beneficial for Lyon County, as well as certain other counties, to withdraw from the amendment process; and

WHEREAS, Lyon County has determined that it would be appropriate and desires to withdraw as so advised; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution was introduced and Steve Herman moved that said Resolution be adopted. The motion was seconded by <u>Dennis Scholten</u>. The roll was called and the vote was AYES: <u>Doug Vacken Bosch</u>, <u>Cory Alterna, Dennis Scholten</u>, Jerry Birkey, Steve Herman NAYS:
