SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

SUMMARY: To authorize a change in the use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax in the city of Alvord of the County of Lyon effective February 2nd, 2026.

To authorize a change in the specific purpose and use of which revenues raised by the local sales and services tax in the City of Alvord of the County of Lyon, are to be expended. The specific purpose of which the revenue shall otherwise be expended shall be changed to: One hundred percent (100%) for city maintenance and other expenditures, to be effective February 2, 2026.

A local sales and service tax was imposed in the City of Alvord of the County of Lyon at the rate of one percent (1%) effective on October 1, 1996. This tax shall continue to be imposed at a rate of one percent (1%) and revenues raised by the tax shall be allocated in the City of Alvord of the County of Lyon as follows:

The use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax shall be changed in the city of Alvord of the County of Lyon effective February 2, 2026.

PROPOSED USES OF THE TAX:

If the change is approved, revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows:

Zero percent (0%) for property tax relief.

The specific purpose and use of which revenues shall otherwise be expended shall be changed to:

One hundred percent (100%) for city maintenance and other expenditures, to be effective on February 2, 2026.

CURRENT USES OF THE TAX:

Revenues from the sales and services tax are currently allocated as follows:

Zero percent (0%) for property tax relief.

The specific purposes for which revenues are otherwise expended are:

Fifty percent (50%) for police protection and fifty percent (50%) for city maintenance and other expenditures.
